Categories:

Student Run Enterprise Prize

Demonstrate an original idea that concluded a successful outcome. This outcome must have yielded a real product or service. Examples: business plan, design, organization structure, manufacturing process, quality assurance/quality control, test and evaluation.

Practical Innovation Award

Demonstrate applied innovation via engineered products/software for use in quality-of-life improvement: health, learning, communications, finance and investment/security.

Career Betterment Grant

Shift from current career track situation into a value added skill career in high demand by U.S. or private sector professional services, manufacturing or skilled craft.

HOW TO QUALIFY

Submit a 500 to 1500 word essay stating:

- Why applicant desires gift
- What uniquely qualifies the applicant
- Anticipated outcomes resulting from the gift
- Intended use of their improved knowledge or skills
- Photos, sketches, drawings or renderings may be submitted
- Papers should be typed using MS Word using Times Roman font, size 10-12 pt.

RECIPIENT ELIGIBILITY

- US citizen
- Applicant has US Military Service Honorable Discharge or is currently serving any active component or reserve components service
- Applicant has no US Military service, and 1) is pursuing an ABET qualified curriculum, science, technology, engineering or math curriculum leading toward professional registration, certification or a skilled trade craft credential that is widely recognized within the US, or 2) K-12 individual or STEM team
